- a) The above table demonstrates Gratiot County's labor force concentration amongst top non-profit/public sector firms. Using the table above, the average number of employees per non-profit/public firm is greater than the average number of employees per private firms. Public sector employers within the county's top ten firms account for 67.1% (2,334) of employees, and the remaining 32.9% (1,144.5) of the top ten are private sector employees. The 3,478.5 employees in the top ten significant firms account for 45.46% of the total significant labor force (7,652). This means that 4,173.5 employees are dispersed amongst the remaining significant firms.
- b) The numbers in the above table can also be examined considering information from the Michigan Labor Market Information website. As of May 2017, there are 17,407 employed people in Gratiot County. The FTEs that are examined cannot exactly be compared as a percentage to the number of employed people in the county because Full-Time Equivalent is a measure of jobs more than of employed people. However, the top ten firms in Gratiot County represent approximately 19.98% of the employed workforce. Further, the fact that the sectors are widely diversified demonstrates growing and significant economic resiliency in the Gratiot-area economy.



This table shows the unemployment rate trends between Gratiot County, the State of Michigan, and the United States over the past 46 years. In the 1970s, Gratiot County's unemployment rate was significantly higher than the state and national rates and experienced similar fluctuations for a long period. Gratiot County experienced an unemployment rate of 21.4% in 1975. For a short time in 2002, Gratiot County had a lower unemployment than both the state and nation. The county was heavily dependent on the automotive parts and petroleum sectors. Today, the petroleum refining sector is gone, and the automotive parts sector is diminished and stable. Smaller and more diversified manufacturing and agri-industry firms are now typical in the Gratiot region.

The *annual average labor force* for 2016 was **18,254** people; **908** of those people were unemployed - this results in an *annual unemployment rate* of **5.0%** for 2016. The most recent rate from May 2017 was **4.2%**, implying a slow but steady improvement in the economic climate since the 2008 Recession. An increasingly diversified economic base has lessened the gap between Gratiot County's unemployment situation compared to that of the state and nation over the long term.

The relatively small total labor force of Gratiot County has a large impact on the degree to which unemployment rates swing up or down. Approximately 200 people gaining or losing employment changes the county average by one full percentage point. A slight change in Gratiot's labor force results in a substantial impact on the county's unemployment rate, minimal effects to the state rate, and is statistically irrelevant to the national rate. Historically, the size of the Gratiot labor force has remained fairly consistent.
