After locating in the Breckenridge Industrial, Technology and Agribusiness Park in 2011, GGDI has assisted Integrity Fab with two expansions. In 2013, the company expanded with \$500,000 in new equipment. In 2016, the company added 35,000 sq. ft. with a \$1.8 million investment. Integrity now employs 80 people!

# Wind Development in Gratiot County





GGDI assisted in the planning and development of two wind parks: Gratiot County Wind, LLC and Beebe Renewable Energy, LLC. These projects resulted in:

- \$30.38 million in additional tax revenue since 2012
  - \$11.75 million to Gratiot County
  - \$14.85 million to local school districts and RESDs
  - \$3.78 million to local townships
- 300 temporary skilled construction jobs and 19 permanent full-time maintenance jobs
- Land payments to benefit approximately 350 families

Pine River Wind Energy, locally approved in 2017, will begin construction in 2018 in Pine River Township and Coe Township in Isabella County.

The program is intended to redevelop sites that are perceived to be environmentally contaminated or obsolete for clean-up/development into useful commercial and industrial sites. As a result, these sites will have greater value, leading to additional tax revenue and increased jobs.








# Growing Opportunities: Gratiot County Agriculture

Agriculture provides the foundation for growth and development in Gratiot County. The economic benefits reaped from agriculture are tremendous; in 2016, agriculture was 22% of the county's tax base and employed over 3,300 on farms and in agribusinesses. Further, the future of agriculture remains strong, as almost 600 youth participate in 4-H programs through MSU Extension. GGDI provides consultation and expansion assistance to agribusinesses in the area.




